Calling High School Artists (Juniors & Seniors Only):

Soroptimist International of Davie is seeking ways to help bring an end to Human Trafficking and we hope you will help! As an artist, you are invited to enter SI Davie's Human Trafficking Poster Competition. High school students from western Broward County are invited to submit their original art for consideration to be published as a printed poster. All entries must be presented in portrait format only with a maximum size of 18 inches by 22 inches. All art mediums will be considered. Three winners will be announced on **Thursday, January 9, 2020** at Old Davie School Historical Museum and the winning artwork may be published as posters and displayed publicly throughout Broward County.

A group of jurists that includes professional artists and community leaders will choose the winners from among the entries submitted. SI Davie will present \$600 in prizes! The top three artists will be awarded ribbons, certificates and cash prizes of \$300 for First Place, \$200 for Second Place and \$100 for Third Place. Additionally, the Teacher of the winning student will receive a \$50 cash award as our thanks.

To be eligible for this competition you must:

- Read through the Criteria very carefully and be sure you understand the application.
- Complete the Application Form following the instructions provided.
- **Deadline for entries is 2 PM on Friday, December 6, 2019.**

HUMAN TRAFFICKING Juried Art Exhibit Criteria & Information

ARTISTS: READ CAREFULLY and FOLLOW DIRECTIONS.

- 1. Due to the mature subject matter**, only entries from a high school **junior or senior** enrolled in a Broward County High School, public or private, will be accepted.
- 2. Entries must be printed.** If your handwriting is illegible, your entry will be disqualified.
- 3. Only individual artists** may enter; group entries will not be considered.
- 4. Tag Your Work!** Include an ID tag on the back of your entry that provides title, artist's full name and phone number in the event your Application is separated from your art entry.
- 5. Criteria** Submit your art entry based on the theme, STOP HUMAN TRAFFICKING. Artwork can be paper or canvas with or without matting. No framed art will be accepted. Maximum dimensions of 18" x 22" will be accepted utilizing portrait layout only.
- 6. Design Elements List** (see Application Form) Include the medium in which the art was created (i.e., acrylic, mixed media, oil, photography, watercolor, etc.).
- 7. Theme.** All entries must address the theme of "**Human Trafficking.**" The message, Human Trafficking, should be clearly portrayed in your art submission. We support freedom of expression; however, art considered to be controversial, offensive or politically charged will not be considered. The use of brand names and commercial endorsement is prohibited. Refrain from the use of profanity or nudity to convey your message. The decisions of the judges is final.
- 8. Parent/Guardian Permission** (see Application Form) Students age 17 and under require a parent or guardian's written consent to participate in this contest. PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY.
- 9. Submit your completed Application Form** with your art entry to Soroptimist International of Davie **no later than 2 PM on Friday, December 6, 2019.** You may deliver them in person or by U.S. mail to: Old Davie School Historical Museum, 6650 Griffin Road, Davie, FL 33314 ATTN: High School Art Contest. - 10. Selection of Finalists:** A panel of jurists that includes artists and community leaders will select the finalists from the artwork submitted and three winning artists will be announced during SI Davie's Human Trafficking Awareness event at Old Davie School on **January 9, 2020.** The finalists' art entries will be exhibited at public and private venues throughout the Town of Davie, Broward County, State of Florida and local media, following the announcement of winners. All entrants will be invited to attend the awards ceremony.
- 11. Judging:** The criteria for finalist selection includes: concept, creativity, design, originality, use of materials, interpretation and execution of the theme "**Human Trafficking,**" following directions and completing the application.
- 12. Decision of the jurists is final.** We are seeking art that is universally appealing and inspiring to viewers of all ages that conveys the message that we must all work to Stop Human Trafficking.
- 13. Prizes:** All finalists receive a certificate of appreciation. Ribbons and cash prizes will be awarded as follows: First Place \$300; Second Place \$200; Third Place \$100. The winning art may be published as posters for distribution throughout Broward County to aid in increasing the public's awareness of "**Human Trafficking**" and the Soroptimist mission to stop it.
- 14. The Fine Print:** Entries will be exhibited at Old Davie School on January 9, 2020. All photos and artwork may be used by Soroptimist International of Davie in any and all media for the purpose of promoting the mission of bringing an end to Human Trafficking. Artwork will be available for return to students, parents or teachers after January 9, 2020 reception. SI Davie is not responsible for entries that are damaged or lost in transit and reserves the right to judge those entries as received.
